Last year the AHEPA Veterans Committee developed a program to honor those who served our country. The program was in two phases.

The first part of this Initiative was focused on our Chapters identifying and designating a Chapter level Liaison that will serve to collect the census information of the Veterans of their respective chapters. This function is integral to the process so that we can begin registering our Veterans and in turn begin to build a database of this information.

Part two and the foundation from which subsequent phases of the Veterans Affairs Committee initiatives will build upon, is now ready. Part two has seen the launch of the Ahepa Veterans Affairs web site (Hot linked through Ahepa.org) that will allow the data entry of Veteran Census information.

In addition to Chapter Level Liaisons, you must appoint a District Level Liaison within your Districts and have him in place to work in tandem with the National Committee. The District Veterans Affairs Liaison can then coordinate with Chapter designated liaisons in order to make this initiative as successful as possible.

The Veterans Affairs Committee has the full support of the National Lodge and will be sending out subsequent updates as this exciting initiative continues to build momentum
