PFC GEORGE DILBOY DEDICATION OF SERVICE AWARD



Now Available to AHEPA Family Chapters and Districts

This new plaque provides a meaningful way to recognize an AHEPA Family member who has served honorably in the United States Armed Forces.

The award honors veterans whose service and character reflect the values of PFC George Dilboy: courage, selflessness, patriotism, loyalty, integrity, and dedication to a cause greater than oneself.

Recommended recipient qualifications

- Current member in good standing of the AHEPA Family
- Honorable service in the U.S. Armed Forces, National Guard, or Reserves
- Demonstrated leadership, sacrifice, devotion to duty, or service to veterans and the community
- Personal conduct reflecting positively upon AHEPA and the Armed Forces

Military rank, combat service, or receipt of a decoration is not required. The award may also be presented posthumously.

ABOUT PFC GEORGE DILBOY

George Dilboy was a Greek-born American soldier who served with Company H, 103rd Infantry Regiment, 26th “Yankee” Division during World War I. He was killed in action on July 18, 1918, at age 22 and was posthumously awarded the Medal of Honor. His courage and sacrifice remain an enduring inspiration to the AHEPA Family.
